SCHOOL DISCIPLINARY RULES

- 1. Student should bring the almanac on daily basis. All the information required in almanac should be duly filled, checked and signed by the parents.
- 2. The student should strictly adhere to the school timings. Coming late to school is not encouraged.
- 3. Students are expected to attend the school on the opening and closing days.
- 4. 100% attendance is essential, however, in case of medical or unavoidable circumstances a maximum 20% can be condoned by the management. Regular attendance is a must for the proper progress of the student.
- 5. Irregular attendance and habitual absence will invite strict action from the school.
- 6. Personal neatness, obedience, good manners and cleanliness are emphasized at all time.
- 7. School circulars / remarks / notes sent from the school should be checked and signed promptly by the parents / guardian. Necessary action should also be taken whenever required within the school rules.
- 8. Guardians should send an application and a medical certificate [in case of more than three days of continuous sickness] for the absence of their ward.
- 9. Students suffering from any contagious/infectious disease will not be permitted to attend the school.
- 10. In case the child is absent from school, he/she must make up for all the work missed out by him/her.
- 11. No re-test will be taken in case of absence during written examination.
- 12. No student will be allowed to go home before time, without the written application from the parents/guardian along with permission of the in charge authorities.
- 13. If there is any change in student's contact details parents/guardians are requested to inform the school authorities at the earliest and same should be changed in the almanac as well.
- 14. Students are strictly prohibited to carry mobile phones to the school.
- 15. For any inquiry of fees and school activities contact the account office. Contact transportation in charge for transport related information and contact sports in charge for sports related information and activities.
- 16. Students are discouraged to bring valuable or expensive things such as watches, pens, gold ornaments, laptop, mobiles, i-pods etc. to the school. The school is not responsible for the loss of these things.
- 17. Parents and guardians are not permitted to visit their wards or meet the teachers in the classrooms without prior permission of the Principal. Parents are not allowed to contact directly any of the teachers on their mobiles.
- 18. Private tuition are strictly discouraged.
- 19. The school will not entertain any application for change of section of any child.
- 20. Interchange of the school campus or medium will not be permitted without the consent of the management.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINARY RULES

- 21. It is compulsory for every student to speak in English language within the school campus.
- 22. Any indecent behavior of student causing damage to school infrastructure is liable to pay for the damage done and strict action shall be taken against the same.
- 23. Students must attend the school in the complete uniform, otherwise strict action will be taken for the same.
- 24. Warning cards will be issued to the student who commits mistake such as disobedience, telling lies, bunking school, bullying, fighting, willfully damaging school property, using obscene language and indulging in violent behavior in the school. Disciplinary action will be taken by the Principal after two warnings.
- 25. Material provided by the school, if lost, would be charged.
- 26. Prizes and certificates will be awarded to outstanding students who excel in behavior, studies, attendance & co-curricular activities conducted by the school.
- 27. Follow the schedule fixed for meeting Principal and Educational Head.
- 28. Parents asking for any duplicate certificate will have to bear the cost.
- 29. Students are not allowed to bring gifts during Birthday, they must come in school Uniform.

FEE RULES

- 1. Fee is to be paid quarterly for primary section (Std. I to VIII) and mentioned in the admission prospectus. Parents should make sure that the fee is paid by the 15th of the respective month (June, Sept, Dec and March).
- 2. On late payment of fee Rs.50/- shall be charged per day.
- 3. Fees once paid are not refundable for any reason whatsoever.
- 4. On Cheque return, Rs. 350/- will be charged as cancellation/bounce charges.

WITHDRAWAL RULES 📅

- 1. Application for withdrawal of a student must be submitted timely duly filled in the prescribed form available from the school.
- 2. Parents ought to submit L.C Application before 31st May. If not, parents will have to pay the term fee of the next month.
- 3. If a student remains absent for first 6 working days continuously of the school term without prior notice, without submitting withdrawal application, the fee for the following term shall be charged. The seat of such a student is also liable to fortified.
- 4. If a child is opting to take Leaving Certificate from the school in middle of the academic year he or she is liable to pay the fee of that respective academic term.
- 5. Transfer Certificates, Leaving Certificates or any other documents required by student from the school will be issued after two working days on receipt of the application and after all dues of the school are settled.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINARY RULES

SCHOOL TRANSPORT RULES

Student can avail the School Transport, according to the availability of seats. The routes of the school buses are planned and the parents should consult the Transport in-charge for necessary details.

- 1. Transport Fee is to be paid in two installments half yearly.
- 2. All students availing the school transport are expected to be at the bus stop at least five minutes before the arrival time. The transport availed will not wait for student reaching late to bus stop.
- 3. It will be the sole responsibility of the parents to escort the pupil to and from the fixed bus stops.
- 4. Any suggestions or complaints should be reported to the Transport Incharge.
- 5. Students should maintain complete discipline in the school bus or else he/she is liable to be punished.
- 6. The children should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
- 7. No student should come near the entry door of the bus unless it has made a complete stop.
- 8. No objects should be thrown inside or outside the bus.
- 9. The front door of the bus is the only authorized entrance and exit, for students.
- 10. If student misses his/her allotted bus, it is the responsibility of the parent to drop their ward to the school. Such a student may however, return home by their allotted bus.
- 11. The buses shall take the halt at the bus stop only and no personalized services to the home or apartment gate will be provided.

ATTENDANCE & LEAVE POLICY



- 1. The incharge person should be informed in written about planned long leave in advance.
- 2. In case of illness the school authorities must be notified within two days by parents or guardians. Medical certificate has to be attached with the leave letter.
- 3. If the child is absent continuously for more than 15 days without notifying the management, the school authorities hold right to cancel the name of the student.
- 4. In case of sickness, half day leave will be considered with permission.
- 5. If a child is suffering from contagious disease, the child should not be sent to school untill he/she recovers completely. Medical Certificate of fitness is required to be submitted, once the child rejoins the school.

ADMISSION POLICY 📳

- 1. Admission will be given on the criteria of age and ability decided by government policy.
- 2. For new admission, students are required to submit Unique ID No. from previous school along with Transfer Certificate.
- 3. A counter sign of the education officer of the respective state on the leaving certificate is necessary for students applying from state other than Gujarat or from any other country outside India.
- 4. The school authorities have the right to refuse any admission without any reason.

RESULT POLICY



- 1. Results of those students whose fees are pending will not be given until the dues are clear.
- 2. If the child leaves the school in between the session, assessment will be shown till the date attended by the child.
- 3. School authority has the right to upgrade result policy.

FOOD AND NUTRIENTS FOR YOUNG LEARNERS

How your child eats today will have an impact on his/her health throughout their growing years. Consuming food helps children and teens to grow, develop, do well academically and feel good about themselves. Good nutrition also helps to prevent child and teen issues such as eating disorders, obesity, dental cavities and iron-deficiency, anemia etc.

Children need to eat a wide range of fruits and vegetables so their growing bodies can get all the vitamins and minerals they need to learn and develop, particularly in the years leading up to starting the school. It is very important for children to learn from an early age about good nutrition, trying new food and making healthy food choices

According to reports from the American Dietetic Association, the students who eat breakfast have better problem-solving abilities, recall, memory, verbal fluency & creativity as compare to students who skip the most important meal of the day i.e. breakfast. These students are also less likely to be absent.

Teaching children the importance of good nutrition throughout childhood will lay the foundation for a healthier and more fulfilling life.

CANTEEN FACILITY OPTIONAL

- 1. Provides nutritionally balanced food to children.
- 2. School lunch meets nutritional standards based on the latest dietary guidelines.
- 3. Specific calorie limits and age-appropriate meals for all the grades.
- 4. Children are more likely to try new food if they see other children eating. For all these, a time tabled snack time, supervised by staff is created to ensure that every child's need is met.

OUTCOMES (F)

- 1. To develop good eating habits.
- 2. To make the children learn about healthy lifestyles, including a healthy diet.
- 3. By offering a variety of food and repeatedly introducing new food, we encourage the children to develop their taste buds.
- 4. To provide an opportunity for children to practice personal hygiene, like washing hands before and after eating, food and drinking water and proper food etiquettes etc.
- 5. To give opportunity for them to learn good social skills and behavior associated with eating.






